

NASA-Mid-Atlantic welcomes you as a Race Entrant to Carolina Motorsports Park on May 5th and 6th, 2007

Please read all of the following information closely.

GETTING THROUGH THE GATE:

No trailer drops or gate entry will be permitted prior to 5:00PM Friday.

Gates close at 10PM on Friday and Saturday nights. If you must arrive after 10PM and before 6:30AM, DO NOT HONK YOUR HORN. Please flash your lights and/or get out of your car and go to the gate attendant to let him know to open the gates. This also applies if you must leave the track during the overnight hours. CMP has received complaints from their neighbors and if they receive more complaints after this event, we will not be able to permit overnight gate arrivals in the future. The complaints they have received have been due to speeding and inappropriate behavior on the main highway and in Kershaw. NASA strives to be a good neighbor and it is our expectation that our members strive for the same.

CAMPING:

There is no fee for camping. There may be a fee for electricity and that fee will be collected by track personnel.

RACER PROCEDURES:

Please renew or apply for your license and take care of any licensing issues prior to coming to the track. It will save you and us time and hassle.

ALL PARTICIPANTS MUST ATTEND THE ALL HANDS MEETING AT 7:45 SAT MORNING AT THE TECH SHED.

Registration

The following system is designed not to penalize those that register late but to reward those that pre-register.

Pick one of the following that applies to you.

- If you *have* **pre-registered** AND **already have a NASA vehicle logbook and annual tech** for your car you **don't** have to go to Techistration (i.e. NO LINES) but you must provide the following to your group liaison on Saturday morning:

Vehicle Logbook with annual tech inspection

Race Car Pre-Tech Form

Current Competition License

If all is in order you will receive your wristband (gets the DRIVER on the track) and your vehicle tech sticker (gets the CAR on the track). Group Liaisons will be introduced during the ALL HANDS MEETING at 7:45 AM

- If you *have pre-registered but DO NOT* have a NASA vehicle logbook and annual tech for your car then you must bring to Techistration the following:

Vehicle (You will be issued a NASA Vehicle Logbook)

Safety Gear

You must provide the following to your group liaison on Saturday morning after the 7:45am ALL HANDS meeting:

Vehicle Logbook

Race Car Pre-Tech Form

Current Competition License

If all is in order you will receive your wristband (gets the DRIVER on the track) and your vehicle tech sticker (gets the CAR on the track). Group Liaisons will be introduced during the ALL HANDS MEETING

Tech:

Unless you have gone to a designated tech station in 2007 prior to this event, you will need an annual tech for the year and a sticker for this event. Please try to arrive Friday evening or EARLY Saturday (open at 6:30AM) to avoid waiting in line. . If you do not have a NASA logbook, one will be given to you. If your car passes tech inspection, you will receive a Tech sticker.

Although we try our best to make announcements for your track time, you should pay careful attention to the time and what group is on track so you will know when to report to grid. Announcements may also be very difficult to hear with noise in the paddock. Always be aware of what group is prior to yours so you will know when to report to grid.

Licensing

All Racers MUST hold a 2007 competition license from NASA . The only exception is:

You are eligible and have applied for a NASA license, but have not yet received the license. In this case, you will need to provide proof at the track that you have applied for your NASA license, including copies of ALL related documentation.

You must also be a current member of NASA.

If you do not have a 2007 license and do not meet the above exceptions, you will need to have a current license with another recognized group (SCCA, BMW, PCA). Please complete the competition license application and submit it to national prior to the weekend if possible, or you may bring the application and required paperwork to the track. Entrants that do not meet the above criteria will not be able to race the weekend. THIS IS AN ABSOLUTE REQUIREMENT.

Mandatory Meetings

You must attend the 7:45 am all hands meeting on Saturday at the Tech Shed. The name of your Group Liaison will be announced at these meetings.

VEHICLE APPEARANCE: Racecars are expected to have a good and clean appearance as viewed from 30 feet away at 30mph. Each racecar must display official NASA stickers (available at tech) easily visible on all four sides.

CAR NUMBER: Your car number is your 1st preference unless you have been or are notified of the need for a change. Car numbers MUST comply with the CCR.

TRANSPONDERS: If you did not include your transponder number with your race entry and do not email it to registration@nasaracing.net before the close of registration, you WILL be charged 25.00 to have it entered at the track. If you are renting a transponder, you are encouraged to pick it up Friday evening in the tech shed. Rental numbers have been recorded for pre-registered persons. When you rent a transponder, you must leave a \$350 deposit by check or credit card. When you return the transponder on Sunday, your deposit will be returned.
