



NASA-Mid Atlantic welcomes you as a Race Entrant at Summit Point!

GATE HOURS: Gates open at 6:00PM Friday and will remain open all night and weekend. **Do not arrive earlier than 6:00PM on Friday because there is another event on track that day and you will NOT be allowed in.** It is highly suggested that you arrive by 7:00 AM or earlier on Saturday morning due to the **mandatory 7:30 AM meeting.** There may be congestion at the gate, so please arrive early.

GETTING THROUGH THE GATE: **Since this is a non-spectator event, all persons entering the track will sign a waiver and will need to indicate they are attending the NASA event. No gate fee**

PARKING: Please conserve space in the paddock. Friends, crew and family must park in woods near the paddock or down toward Turn 1. **Open trailers should be parked at the backside of Turn 10 or in the Turn 1 camping area.**

RACER PROCEDURES:

2010 NASA Mid-Atlantic procedures will be followed for obtaining your track wristband. Please see procedures below for obtaining your permanent 2010 tech sticker if you do not have one already. **YOU MUST WEAR BOTH WRISTBANDS** (gate and participant wristbands) **ALL WEEKEND.** **YOU MUST ATTEND 7:30 AM ALL HANDS MEETING ON SATURDAY AT TECH SHED.**

VEHICLE APPEARANCE: Racecars are expected to have a good and clean appearance as viewed from 30 feet away at 30mph. Each racecar must display official NASA stickers (available at tech) easily visible on all four sides.

CAR NUMBER: Your car number is your 1st preference unless you have been or are notified of the need for a change.

TRANSPONDERS: If you did not include your transponder number with your race entry, please e-mail it to registration@nasaracing.net. **If you wait until you arrive at the track to submit important info such as your transponder number, correct car number and/or make any changes/additions to your entry, you will pay \$25.** If you are renting a transponder, you are encouraged to pick it up Friday evening in the tech shed. Rental numbers have been recorded for preregistered persons. When you rent a transponder, you must leave a \$450 deposit by check or credit card. When you return the transponder on Sunday, your deposit will be returned.

TECHISTRATION HOURS (tech shed):

Friday 6:30PM until 9:00PM

Saturday 6:30AM until 9:30AM

Sunday 7:00AM until 9:30AM

SCHEDULE AND SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS: (TO BE POSTED TEN DAYS PRIOR TO EVENT) Go to event page.

Although we try our best to make announcements for your track time, you should pay careful attention to the time and what group is on track so you will know when to report to grid. Announcements may also be very difficult to hear with noise in the paddock. Always be aware of what group is prior to yours so you will know when to report to grid.

Registration and Tech (i.e. Techistration)

The following system is designed not to penalize those that register late but to reward those that pre-register and have renewed their license.

Pick one of the following that applies to you.

- If you *have* pre-registered AND already have a permanent 2010 annual race sticker, you do not need to go to techistration. You must provide the following to your group liaison on Saturday morning:

Vehicle Logbook with annual tech inspection notation

Current Competition License

No need to bring an annual tech form since you have already submitted one and have an annual race sticker. If all is in order you will receive your wristband (gets the DRIVER on the track). Group Liaisons will be introduced during the ALL HANDS MEETING at 7:30 AM

- If you *have* pre-registered and have your 2010 license, but DO NOT have a NASA vehicle logbook and/or annual tech for your car: then you must bring to Techistration the following:

Vehicle (You will be issued a NASA Vehicle Logbook)

Safety Gear

Race Car Pre-Tech form

If your car passes tech, you will receive a permanent 2010 annual race sticker to be used all year.

***To receive your track wristband, you will show your 2010 NASA License with valid medical to your liaison at the 7:30 meeting on Saturday morning.

If you have not registered, or do not have a 2010 license or tech inspection, you will need to come to techistration.
