



## **NASA Mid-Atlantic welcomes YOU as an HPDE student at Summit Point!**

**GATE HOURS:** Gates open at 6:00PM Friday and will remain open all night/weekend. It is highly suggested that you arrive before 7:00AM Saturday morning due to the mandatory 7:30AM meeting. There may be congestion at the gate, so please arrive early. **Do not arrive earlier than 6:00PM on Friday because there is another NON-NASA event on track that day and you will NOT be allowed in.**

**GETTING THROUGH THE GATE:** **Since this is a non-spectator event, all persons entering the track will sign a waiver and will need to indicate they are attending the NASA event. No gate fee.**

**PROCEDURES:** Normal NASA Mid-Atlantic procedures will be followed for obtaining both your on-track wristband and tech sticker. **YOU MUST WEAR BOTH WRISTBANDS** (gate and participant wristbands) **ALL WEEKEND.** Please conserve space in the paddock. Friends, crew and family must park in woods near the paddock or down toward Turn 1. We ask drivers to park open trailers in Turn 10.

**HPDE 1 and HPDE 2:** You will receive your track wristband at your first classroom. Your car will be inspected by your instructor on grid prior to your first on-track session, and you will receive your tech sticker at that time. **You DO NOT need to check in at the techistration area. Make sure you attend the ALL HANDS meeting at 7:30 AM AT THE TECH SHED AREA.** To get your tech sticker, you must have the pre-tech form completed, so do this prior to going to grid. Your instructor will go over your pre-tech form and do a tech inspection of your car. If you are knowledgeable about your car and are competent to check all items on the form, you may complete the form yourself. **HPDE 3:** In HPDE 3 (advanced group), you are not assigned an instructor. HPDE 3 Level indicates that you have significant experience on a variety of tracks, and your experience will be verified. You must report to techistration to retrieve your on-track wristband, and you need to bring your car through the tech shed to receive your tech sticker. Please give your completed pre-tech sheet to a tech official and check in at the registration table to retrieve your wristband. Tech form found here:

Please see schedule for your first classroom time and first on-track session. Although we try our best to make announcements for your track time, you should pay careful attention to the time and what group is on track so you will know when to report to grid. Always be aware of what group is prior to yours so you will know when to report to grid.

**CAR NUMBER:** Your car number is your 1st preference unless you have been or are notified of the need for a change. **You are responsible to have your car numbered before it will be allowed on the track. Numbers should be 10 inches tall on both sides of the car.**
