



## **NASA Mid-Atlantic welcomes you as a Time Trial Entrant at Summit Point Raceway!**

**GATE HOURS:** Gates open at 6:00PM Friday and will remain open all night/weekend. It is highly suggested that you arrive by 7:00AM Saturday morning due to the mandatory 7:30AM meeting. There may be congestion at the gate, so please arrive early. **Do not arrive earlier than 6:00PM on Friday because there is another NON NASA event on track that day and you will NOT be allowed in.**

**GETTING THROUGH THE GATE:** Since this is a non-spectator event, all persons entering the track will sign a waiver and will need to indicate they are attending the NASA event. No gate fee.

Please conserve space in the paddock. Friends, crew and family must park in woods near the paddock or down toward Turn 1. We ask drivers to park open trailers in Turn 10.

**PROCEDURES:** Normal NASA Mid-Atlantic procedures will be followed for obtaining both your on-track wristband and tech sticker. YOU MUST WEAR BOTH WRISTBANDS (gate and participant wristbands) ALL WEEKEND.

**WRISTBANDS:** To receive your participant wristband which allows you on track, you will meet with Time Trials Director, Jon Felton after the mandatory All Hands Meeting at 7:30 on Saturday morning.

**TECH:** You must bring your car through tech to receive your tech sticker for the weekend. Be sure to have a completed tech form.

### **TECHISTRATION HOURS (tech shed):**

Friday 6:30PM until 9:00PM

Saturday 6:30AM until 9:30AM

Sunday 7AM until 9:30AM

**MANDATORY MEETINGS: 7:30AM on Saturday near Tech Shed.** All Time Trial entrants will meet immediately after that meeting with Jon Felton, TT Director. He will let you know if there is a mandatory meeting on Sunday.

**TRACK TIME:** Time Trialers first PRACTICE session is on Sat and Sun is with HPDE 3/4 and TT entrants must adhere to those passing rules which are: Passing anywhere with a required point bye. For timed TT sessions, there is open passing.

**CAR NUMBER:** Your car number is your first preference unless notified. You are responsible for having numbers on both sides of your car before coming to tech. Please see CCRs at [nasaproring.com](http://nasaproring.com) if you have any questions.

**SCHEDULE AND SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS: It is your responsibility to read the supplemental regulations and be aware of all rules for this event. These are posted at the event page approximately ten days prior to the event.**

Although we try our best to make announcements for your track time, you should pay careful attention to the time and what group is on track so you will know when to report to grid. Announcements may also be very difficult to hear with noise in the paddock. Always be aware of what group is prior to yours so you will know when to report to grid.
