



## NASA Welcomes You as a Hyperdrive Entrant at Summit Point Raceway on Saturday October 13!

**GATE HOURS:** Gates will open at 5:30PM on Friday and will remain open all weekend. If you do not plan to arrive until Saturday morning for your hyperdrive, please arrive by 9:15AM. This is a non-spectator event so there will be no gate fee.

**CAMPING:** Camping is free but please pay at the gate if you want electricity.

**WRISTBANDS:** You must wear your gate wristband (which you get at the gate) and your participant wristband all weekend. You will receive your participant wristband at your first classroom session.

**TECH: 9:30AM SATURDAY MORNING:** You must bring your car to be inspected (at tech shed) between 9:30 and 10:00AM on Saturday morning to receive your tech sticker. **TECHISTRATION HOURS (tech shed):** **If you bring your car to tech earlier than your scheduled time, please make sure that the tech officials know that you are a hyperdriver. You do NOT need to check in at the registration tables at tech since you will get your wristband from your classroom. If you received an e-mail confirmation, that is your confirmation that you are entered.**

Friday 6:30PM until 9:00PM

Saturday 6:30AM until 9:30AM

**MANDATORY MEETINGS:** We do have a meeting scheduled at 7:45AM on Saturday morning for all drivers and workers; but this meeting is intended for drivers who are participating in the weekend-long activities. You may attend this meeting at the tech shed but you do not have to. Your first assignment is tech at 9:30 and then classroom as noted on the schedule. Please see schedule for your listed track time. The classroom is located on the opposite end of the building from concessions.

**GRIDDING:** You may report to grid anytime after the group before you leaves the grid. Your instructor will meet you on grid and hop in your car.

**CAR NUMBER:** Your car number is your first preference unless notified. You are responsible for having numbers on your car before coming to tech. You may use prepared numbers, painter's tape or duct tape and the numbers should be approximately 10 inches tall. Numbers should be on both sides of the car.

**CLOTHING:** You must wear long pants and closed-toed shoes for your hyperdrive session. You must also have a helmet. If you do not own a helmet, please retrieve one from the tech shed. You will need to leave a deposit such as a driver's license for the helmet.

**SCHEDULE AND SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS:** **It is your responsibility to read the supplemental regulations and be aware of all rules for this event. Posted at event page approximately one week prior to event.**

During lunchtime on Sunday, we offer Touring Laps for \$15 per car. Drive your car at a spirited speed behind a pace car (no passing). You may take as many passengers as you have seatbelts. No helmets required.
