NASA Mid Atlantic will see you on Friday February 19 at VIR Full Course for Open Track Practice. Open Track is for HPDE 3 (Advanced) Students and Instructors (HPDE 4 level). If you are a racer, you should have preregistered for Test and Tune so please contact registration@nasaracing.net if you are signed up incorrectly.

No trailer drops or gate entry will be permitted prior to 5:30PM Thursday.

VIR CAMPING COSTS: \$35 to camp without electricity. \$25 for Electric only. \$50 if you are camping and need electricity.

GATE FEES: VIR will charge \$10 at the gate beginning at 8:30am on Saturday morning. Anyone arriving after 8:30am may show their NASA membership card to gain free access. If you have crew arriving after 8:30AM, they should list you as the driver and indicate they are a part of your crew. The gate will have an entrant list.
