



## Test & Tune

NASA Mid Atlantic will see you on Friday February 19 at VIR Full Course for the Test and Tune. You must have a 2010 NASA or other approved sanctioning body race license or have sufficient credentials to apply for a 2010 NASA race license to participate. The cost of a license is \$70. If you have licensing questions, please contact [beth@nasaracing.net](mailto:beth@nasaracing.net) RENEW EARLY!!!!!!

If you are an advanced/HPDE 3 driver and signed up for Test and Tune, you should be signed up for Open Practice instead. Please notify [registration@nasaracing.net](mailto:registration@nasaracing.net) so as to avoid delays at the track.

No trailer drops or gate entry will be permitted prior to 5:30PM Thursday.

**VIR CAMPING COSTS:** \$35 to camp without electricity. \$25 for Electric only. \$50 if you are camping and need electricity.

**GATE FEES:** VIR will charge \$10 at the gate beginning at 8:30am on SATURDAY morning. Anyone arriving after 8:30am may show their NASA membership card to gain free access. If you have crew arriving after 8:30 AM on Sat, they should list you as the driver and indicate they are part of your crew. The gate will have a list of entrants.

Your car number is your 1st preference unless you are notified of the need for a change.

Unless you have an annual tech inspection for 2009, all test and tune/race cars will need to come through techstration to receive their annual tech and tech sticker. If you have an annual inspection, you will only need to bring your race car logbook and completed tech form to tech to get your sticker. Arrive Thursday evening (preferable) or early Friday morning. Since you go out on track first, you should arrive early to make certain you do not miss track time. To receive your wristband that allows you on track, please see registration in the tech shed. You must show a current competition license to receive the wristband.
