



**NASA-Mid-Atlantic welcomes you as an Entrant for the Super Competition School on Friday
July 27 at VIR North Course!**

Please read all of the following information closely.

GETTING THROUGH THE GATE:

No trailer drops or gate entry will be permitted prior to 5:30PM Thursday. After that, the gates will be open 24 hours a day during the entire weekend.

VIR CAMPING COSTS: \$35 to camp without electricity. \$25 for Electric only. \$50 if you are camping and need electricity.

GATE FEES: Gates will open at 5:30pm on Thursday 7/26 and will remain open all weekend.

No trailer drops or gate entry will be permitted prior to 5:30pm Thursday. New for this year VIR will charge \$10 at the gate. Anyone arriving after 8:30am Friday may show their NASA membership card to gain free access. If you have crew arriving after 8:30am, they should list you as the driver and indicate they are a part of your crew. The gate staff will have a list of all pre-registered entrants. Camping for the weekend will cost \$35 without electricity, \$25 for electric only, or \$50 if you are camping and need electricity.

PROCEDURES:

Registration

If your experience has not already been cleared by Chris Cobetto, please e-mail him at chris@nasaracing.net. All entrants must be pre-approved.

If you are preregistered and have mailed all your materials in advance, you will not need to check in at registration. You will be notified by e-mail five days prior to the event if there are missing materials from your application. Remember that you needed to mail this in by 7 days prior to the address listed below:

We also recommend that you preregister to race even though we do not yet know if you will pass the Competition School. If you do pass the school, you will be already entered as a race entrant and will not need to complete any further paperwork at the track. If you do not pass the clinic, we can give you a full refund of your race entry or transfer it over to an HPDE 3 entry for the weekend. Thanks!

All entrants will receive their wristband from their first classroom session.

THERE IS A MANDATORY ALL HANDS MEETING FOR ALL ENTRANTS AT 7:45AM Friday AT TECH SHED.

Tech:

Unless you have gone to a designated tech station in 2007 prior to this event, you will need an annual race tech for the year and a sticker for this event. Please try to arrive Thursday

evening or EARLY Friday morning (open at 6:30AM). A NASA Logbook will be issued to you if you do not have one. If your car passes the race tech inspection, you will receive a Tech sticker.

SCHEDULE AND SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS:

Schedule and supplemental regulations will be posted by 10 days prior.

Although we try our best to make announcements for your track time, you should pay careful attention to the time and what group is on track so you will know when to report to grid.

Announcements may also be very difficult to hear with noise in the paddock. Always be aware of what group is prior to yours so you will know when to report to grid.

Here is some general info about the school:

The Competition School will consist of about 2.5 hours of track time on Friday plus classroom sessions. There will also be a panel of racers to whom you may ask questions. During your track time, there will be several experienced racers who will be in the field evaluating your performance and setting up challenges and fun exercises for you! You will practice standing starts, rolling starts, leapfrog passing and more drills. At the end of the day on Friday, there will be a practice race followed by a written test of the club codes and regulations (CCR's). Please be sure and read the section concerning flags closely as this is most important. You would hate to pass the driving portion but fail a written test concerning use of flags!!!
