

NASA Mid-Atlantic welcomes YOU as an HPDE student to Virginia International Raceway's VIR North Course July 27th-29th, 2007

Below you will find both general guidelines for participating in the school and group specific instructions for each HPDE level.

GATE HOURS: The gate will open for trailer drops on Thursday at 5:30 pm. The gates will remain open for the balance of the weekend since overnight camping is permitted.

GATE FEES: Gates will open at 5:30pm on Thursday 7/26 and will remain open all weekend. No trailer drops or gate entry will be permitted prior to 5:30pm Thursday. New for this year VIR will charge \$10 at the gate. Anyone arriving after 8:30am Friday may show their NASA membership card to gain free access. If you have crew arriving after 8:30am, they should list you as the driver and indicate they are a part of your crew. The gate staff will have a list of all pre-registered entrants. Camping for the weekend will cost \$35 without electricity, \$25 for electric only, or \$50 if you are camping and need electricity.

CAMPING:

There is a \$35 fee for camping without electricity and the fee is 50.00 if you wish to camp AND have electricity. Electricity for non-campers is \$25 for the weekend. These fees are charged and collected by VIR either at the gate or during the weekend by VIR Personnel.

HPDE 1 and 2 PROCEDURES:

Normal NASA Mid-Atlantic procedures will be followed for obtaining both your on-track wristband and tech sticker.

YOU MUST WEAR YOUR WRISTBAND ALL WEEKEND.

You will receive your participant wristband from your first classroom session. You will receive your tech sticker for your car on grid just prior to your first on-track session. To get your tech sticker, you must have the pre-tech form completed and signed, so do this prior to going to grid. Your instructor will go over your pre-tech form and do a tech inspection of your car. If you are knowledgeable about your car and are competent to check all items on the form, you may complete the form yourself. Since HPDE 1 and 2 students get their wristband from classroom and tech sticker from their instructor, these students **do not need to go to the techstration area to check in.**

At the techstration area (tech shed) and on the classroom door, the instructor/student assignments will be posted, so you can check to see that you are listed and see who your instructor is. **YOUR FIRST ASSIGNMENT IS TO ATTEND THE MANDATORY 7:30AM ALL HANDS MEETING AT THE TECH AREA. BE THERE ON TIME OR YOU MAY LOSE TRACK TIME!**

HPDE 3:

In HPDE 3 (advanced group), you are not assigned an instructor. HPDE 3 indicates that you have significant experience on a variety of tracks, and your experience will be verified.

You **must report to techistration** to retrieve your on-track wristband, and you need to bring your car through the tech shed to receive your tech sticker. Be sure to bring a completed pre-tech sheet to a tech official.

CAR NUMBER: Your car number is your 1st preference unless you have been or are notified of the need for a change via email. You are responsible for having numbers on your car before getting on the track.

Friday 6:30PM until 9:00PM

Saturday 6:30AM until 9:00AM

Sunday 7:00AM until 9:00AM

SCHEDULE AND SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS:

Although we try our best to make announcements for your track time, you should pay careful attention to the time and what group is on track so you will know when to report to grid. Always be aware of what group is prior to yours so you will know when to report to grid.

Long sleeves are required for HPDE students for VIR while on track

QUIET HOUR

Please remember the track enforces a quiet hour on Sunday from 11-12. Only cars with ABSOLUTELY stock exhausts may be cranked during this hour.
