



NASA Welcomes You as a Hyperdrive Entrant at VIR Full Course on Saturday March 27!

GATE HOURS: Since this is a three day event, gates will open at 5:30PM on Thursday and will remain open all weekend. If you do not plan to arrive until Saturday morning for your hyperdrive, please arrive by 9:00AM.

VIR CAMPING COSTS: \$35 to camp without electricity. \$25 for Electric only. \$50 if you are camping and need electricity.

GATE FEES: VIR will charge \$10 at the gate beginning at 8:30AM on Saturday morning. Anyone arriving after then may show a NASA membership card (quickest option) to gain free access. If you do not have a NASA membership card, you may state that you are with the NASA event and a driver, and they will refer to a list. If you have crew or friends arriving after that time, they should list you as a driver and mention they are your crew to gain free access.

WRISTBANDS: You must wear your gate wristband (which you get after signing the waiver at the gate) and your participant wristband all weekend. You will receive your participant wristband at your classroom session.

You must bring your car to be inspected (at the tech shed) between 8:45 and 9:30 on Saturday morning to receive your tech sticker. Be sure to have a completed pre-tech form.

TECHISTRATION HOURS:

Thursday evening: 6:30-9:00PM

Friday morning: 6:30-9:30AM

Friday 6:00PM until 9:00PM

Saturday 6:30AM until 9:30AM

Sunday 7AM until 9:30AM

If you bring your car to tech earlier than your scheduled time, please make sure that the tech officials know that you are a hyperdriver since there will be a special sticker for that. You do NOT need to check in at the registration tables at tech since you will get your wristband from your classroom.

MANDATORY MEETINGS: We do have a meeting scheduled at 7:30AM on Saturday morning for all drivers and workers; but this meeting is intended for drivers who are participating in the weekend-long activities. You may attend this meeting at the tech shed but you do not have to. Your first assignment is tech and then please see the schedule for your exact classroom time (usually around 10AM) and track time (usually around noon). The classroom is located on the lower level of the large red barn building on the front straight of the racetrack.

GRIDDING: You may report to grid anytime after the group before you leaves the grid. Please enter the grid at the halfway point down grid row (and NOT at the entrance next to the big red barn building where the classroom is). If you have any questions about where this location is, just ask any official or racer. Your instructor will meet you on grid and hop in your car.

CAR NUMBER: Your car number is your first preference unless notified. You are responsible for having numbers on your car before coming to tech. You may use prepared numbers, racer tape, painter's tape and the numbers should be approximately 10 inches tall. Numbers should be on both sides of the car.

CLOTHING: You must wear long sleeves, long pants and closed-toed shoes for your hyperdrive session. You must also have a helmet. If you do not own a helmet, please retrieve one from the tech shed. You will need to leave a deposit such as a driver's license for the helmet.

SCHEDULE AND SUPPLEMENTAL REGULATIONS: It is your responsibility to read the supplemental regulations and be aware of all rules for this event. Posted at event page approximately one week prior to event.

From time to time, there can be slight delays in track time. Although we try our best to make announcements for your track time, you should pay careful attention to the time and what group is on track so you will know when to report to grid. Announcements may also be very difficult to hear with noise in the paddock. Be aware of what group is prior to yours so you will know when to report to grid (please ask grid if you are unsure what group is out).

TOURING LAPS:

During the lunch hour on Sunday, we offer Touring Laps for \$15 per car. Drive your car at a spirited speed behind a pace car (no passing). You may take as many passengers as you have seatbelts. No helmets required.
