



Instructor Clinic:

NASA Mid Atlantic looks forward to seeing you at the upcoming Instructor Clinic! To register for the Level 1 Instructor Clinic, you need at least 30 track days on a variety of tracks and your experience will be verified. To be able to enroll in the Level 2 clinic, you must have taken Level 1.

If we are offering two clinics on the same weekend, the lower level (Level 1) will hold its classroom time on Thursday evening from 5-9PM. The track time will be on Friday. The second clinic classroom and track time will be on Friday. Please preregister early so that we will know if we have sufficient enrollment. If you want to do both clinics, there is a \$50 discount on the second entry. Please contact laura@nasaracing.net for details.

If you plan on instructing over the weekend, you must sign up for that in addition to your instructor clinic entry. There is a separate line item for that on the registration page.

No trailer drops or gate entry will be permitted prior to 5:30PM Thursday. Gates will remain open all night from Thursday evening until Sunday at 7PM.

VIR CAMPING COSTS: \$35 to camp without electricity. \$25 for Electric only. \$50 if you are camping and need electricity.

GATE FEES: VIR will charge \$10 at the gate beginning at 8:30am on Friday morning. Anyone arriving after 8:30am may show their NASA membership card to gain free access. If you have crew that are arriving after 8:30 Sat, they should list your name and state they are part of your crew to gain free access. The gate will have a list of entrants.

Your car number is your 1st preference unless you are notified of the need for a change.

When you arrive at the track:

1. Cars of instructor clinic participants must come through techistration to receive their tech sticker. Arrive Thursday evening (preferable) or early Fri morning.
2. You must bring to Techistration your vehicle and completed Pre-Tech form found at the link below.
3. If your vehicle passes the tech inspection, you will receive a tech sticker.
4. At your first classroom session, you will receive your wristband that allows you on track.
